Training programme for VET professionals

TOOLKIT for apprentices and SMEs

As part of the development of the second output of the project, all partners interviewed SME managers and VET trainers during the summer in order to find out what tools are needed to foster long term mobilities for apprenticeship. The results have been collected and are now being used to develop the toolkit. This instrument will be soon available on the website.

LTTA - Transnational Training Course

From the 27th of September to the 1st of October, the project partner Berlink organised the first online transnational training course of Mob4app. During the course, fourteen participants from the partners' Project (Co.Meta, Pro Work, Cisl Marche, Pedagogical University, BICC, SCC) discovered how to promote, guide and facilitate long-term mobility experiences.

On the 8th of October, representatives from all the partners gathered for the second online Transnational Project Meeting. This meeting was fundamental to discuss the state of the art of the project, analyse the future strategies and collect opinions on how to structure the next activities.
